

Citrus College ADN Program FAQ's

Q: When is the application period?

A: Citrus' ADN program accepts applications once a year for fall admission for both the Generic and Advanced Placement options. The filing period is in between January through April of each year. Application packets and instructions may be viewed on the nursing website in December. Please go to www.citruscollege.edu/academics/programs/adn for updates.

Applications must be submitted by appointment with a Nursing Counselor only. Please do not mail applications.

Q: My sciences and general education courses are older than five years, will Citrus accept them?

A: Currently the Citrus College ADN program does not have a recency requirement for core sciences and general education courses.

Q: Is there a waiting list?

A: No. There is no waiting list. Accepted students will begin in the fall semester.

Q: Are repeats in the core sciences allowed?

A: Only one repeat is allowed for core sciences with a grade of C or below. Applicants must not exceed one repeat if the class was taken within the last 5 years.

Q: Can any of my classes be in progress when I apply?

A: Pre-requisites (Human Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, and English) cannot be in progress. These courses must be completed, with grades posted on transcripts, prior to applying to the ADN program.

It is highly recommended that no more than two (2) general education courses be in progress at the time an application is submitted. The number of general education courses completed may be considered in selection.

Q: How many students do you accept for the RN Program?

A: We accept 24 students for the Generic option and 12 for the Advanced Placement.

Q: Are online lecture and labs accepted for the Human Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology?

A: No. At this time Citrus' ADN program will only accept *in-class* courses for the above core sciences.

Q: Does the TEAS V test need to be taken prior to applying for the program? Will the Citrus Nursing Program accept TEAS V scores taken at other schools?

A: No. Only admitted students take the TEAS V test at Citrus and only TEAS V scores taken at Citrus College will be accepted.

Q: If I am a Veteran, do I get priority admission into the ADN program?

A: Applicants who are Veterans must show proof of status by submitting a supporting document (i.e. DD-214) to the Veterans Office located in the SS (Student Services) Building, 2nd floor. At the time of application, a copy of the supporting document must also be submitted to the nursing counselor.

Applicants with Veteran status will be given priority after all selection criteria have been met (For example: Two applicants are tied at a 3.8 GPA, the applicant with Veteran status will be given priority).

Q: How can I make an appointment to see a Nursing Counselor?

A: You must have a Citrus student ID# to make an appointment. This can be obtained by applying for admissions to Citrus College at www.citruscollege.edu
